PREACHERS GATHER FOR BIBLE SEMINAR IN ADDIS ABABA:



On April 26th-29th seventy-five preachers and church leaders came to the school compound in Addis Ababa for a three-day bible seminar. Their coming was for two reasons. The first was that John Ed Clark was there for his final trip to Ethiopia and they came to pay their respects. The second was an opportunity to come together for an extended bible study,

which was the first since Covid came to that country in early 2020. It was a great time of spiritual uplifting and old-fashioned fellowship. Some who came have known John Ed for more than 50 years. A few had been students in the Addis School of Preaching when John Ed was teaching in the late 60's and early 70's. A few were grandchildren of those brethren! One came from a new outreach area in Guder, near Ambo, where the work is only three years old and an example of how the work continues to expand by using World Bible School courses.











Bible classes were conducted in the new Advanced School of Preaching facility on the church compound in Addis Ababa. The teachers were (top left to right) Joe Boe, Moges Wolde, Alemayehu Desalegn, Habtu Zemech, and Behailu Abebe. Plans are being made to start a two-year Advanced School of

Preaching. The new facility should be ready in a few months and recruitment of teachers from America will begin. Brethren will be asked to teach 3 week courses following a Sunset International Bible Institute curriculum.
