Most of us live time-conscious lives. We stick to tight schedules, glance at our clocks frequently, and hurry around to meet our appointments and deadlines. Time is certainly important, but the real value of time comes with the realization that our time here on earth is a countdown to eternity.

That means influencing and teaching the lost (Matt. 28:18-20). He wants them taught before time runs out (Titus 2:11-14; 2 Thess. 1:7-10). What are you doing with your time?

- Matt 7:7-8. What things does Jesus want us to ask, seek and knock after?
- Jeremiah 29:11-14. Does the church in the West live in exiled existence? Is it alienated from the culture? A similar question might be, "Is this world my home?"
- Luke 6:12-13. How long did Jesus spend praying? How often do you seek God and for what reasons?
- **Phip 4:6-7**. What is Paul asking us to do in this passage? Are we being told to be "apathetic" about things?
- Matthew 6:25-34. All of us are seeking something and we are going somewhere to get it. Are we seeking God's kingdom? Are we sharing Jesus' concerns?
