Our Perspective of "the-other-guy"

- Psalm 17:3-5 . Sometimes, it's easy for us in these sermons to get puffed up with notions of our own self
- The Gospel reminds us that God is not a respecter of, and we all need God's, too. Luke 18:9-14
- We have been called to and to, and leave behind those things that harm us. Hebrew 12:1; Acts 26:20 .
- We have a tendency to vilify the Pharisee and admire the Tax Collector, but that would completely miss the point of the parable.
- What is the parable about? v. 14.
- Luke 19:8-10 & 18:19-21. We have real life examples of a law follower who left unjustified, and a tax collector who left justified.
- We really need to strive to keep an even keel in our perspectives of who others are, and who we are.
